Our basic service charge includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with responsible party; preparation of necessary certificates and permits; placing of obituary in local newspaper; planning for service arrangements; and coordination of service with cemetery, crematory and others, as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility, such as insurance, maintenance, utility and depreciation expenses, administrative and secretarial expenses, and equipment and inventory expenses. This fee for basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangement you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burial, and receiving and forwarding of remains. This charge is non-declinable.

2. For funeral, memorial service or private serv. on SATURDAY, add \$180; for funeral, memorial serv., or private serv. on Sunday, holiday, or after 4 PM, add \$280.

3. All automotive costs are for local trips only. For distances in excess of 40 miles, one way, from our mortuary, an added mileage charge will be made.

4. Reception charge includes us of facilities, linen service, disposable cups & plates, and service of attendant.

5. If you choose a funeral service where a rental casket is provided, the casket used for the funeral service may have been used in a previous funeral service. If the casket had been used in a previous funeral service, the interior lining has been replaced or thoroughly cleaned.

ALTERNATIVE SERVICES

DIRECT CREMATION \$2,410 to \$3,330

Charge includes removal of the remains, custodial care, transfer to the crematory and basic services of the funeral director and staff. Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are fiberboard, plywood and/or cardboard. **This charge does NOT include any visitation, rites or ceremonies.** This charge includes a payment to Riverside Cemetery, Fargo, (\$375) for the crematory fee and Cass County cremation registration fee (\$10).

Charge includes removal of the remains, custodial care, transfer to the cemetery, a graveside service, and basic services of the funeral director and staff. **This charge includes a graveside service, but no other ceremonies.**

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME \$2,885

Charge includes removal of the remains, embalming, air shipment container, transfer to the airport and basic services of the funeral director and staff. **This charge does NOT include any visitation, rites or ceremonies.**
